June 25th and 26th will be here before you know it! These dates are for our 13th annual Field Day and Auction. This event is THE event of the year and the chance to showcase the best of the best in our breed. All animals submitted to the sale will be reviewed and approved by the field day committee to be in the auction.

If you are looking to consign any animals to the 13th Annual Field Day and Auction, please fill out the form below. Animals must have the Fullblood or Purebred (including breed up) status to be included in the sale.

The auction will be the same style and format as years past with the following minor changes:

- Each consignor can only consign up to 4 animals
- Base prices have been modified
 - Bulls will start at \$2000
 - Heifers will start at \$1500
 - Pairs will start at \$2000
 - If animals do not bring the base price, it will be considered a “No Sale”
- Any animal is subject to removal from the sale up to and including at the time of arrival to the event
- Any animal pulled for any seller’s reason other than health, within 48 hours of the sale will be subject to a \$250 fine

The rest of the sale rules are on the following page for your review. The deadline for submitting animals and photos is **May 12, 2021**. By extending out to this date, we are hoping to allow for the grass to green and animals to be in spring condition, but this date is the last date we can accept animals for the catalog.

We are looking forward to working with you all on this sale and would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your support of the Association.

1. All interested buyers must sign in at the registration table and receive a numbered buyers card. Settlement by cash or check must be made with clerk immediately following auction and before cattle are loaded.
2. All animals for sale will be identified by lot number.
3. Opening bid prices will be: Bulls \$2000; Heifers \$1500; Cow/Calf pairs \$2000. If animals do not bring the minimum, they will be considered a "No Sale".
4. All animals will be available for inspection after 12 noon on Friday, June 25th.
5. Cattle will be sold as listed in the catalog at 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 26th. More information will be available sale day.
6. Trucking will be available sale day. Cattle may not be loaded until after conclusion of sale and payment made. Any longer-term arrangements will need to be made with landowners.
7. Any corrections of printed material will be addressed prior to the sale. Any announcements made will supersede any catalog information.
8. All weaning age cattle being sold without dam at side, must be weaned at least 30 days prior to auction.
9. All sale cattle must be registered by consignor prior to being listed in the sale catalog. Registration certificate on each animal will be transferred to the buyer at the association's expense. The buyer is responsible for the proper address and contact information given to the clerk.
10. A current health certificate is required on each consigned animal upon arrival. After the auction, health certificates will be furnished on all sold animals as required for shipping.
11. Non-virgin bulls or bulls greater than 12 months of age must be trichomonas tested and negative results must accompany bull on arrival. These bulls must also pass a breeding soundness exam prior to the sale.
12. Mail or phone bids will be accepted, but arrangements must be made in advance by calling the SPGCA at 256-996-8355.
13. All persons who attend this sale do so at their own risk and owners or SPGCA assume no liability or otherwise for any accidents which may occur.
14. Seller of the animal must be a current member of the SPGCA.
15. SPGCA has the right to visually inspect and deny/refuse any cattle delivered to auction to maintain the standards expected of our breed.
16. All animals are consigned at the risk of the owner.

COWBOY AUCTION FORMAT

Each animal to be sold to the highest bidder. All cattle will have a base price as listed on rule #3. If more than one buyer is interested in purchasing a lot, the base price will be raised in \$100 increments until only one bidder is left.
