

SALE RULES

1. All interested buyers must sign in at registration table and receive a numbered buyer's card. Settlement by cash or check must be made with clerk immediately following auction and before cattle are loaded.
2. All animals for sale will be identified by Lot Number.
3. Suggested opening bid price will be \$1,000 on heifers, \$1,500 on bulls and \$1,800 on cow/calf pairs.
4. All animals will be available for inspection after noon on Friday, June 21.
5. Cattle will be sold as listed in catalog at 3 p.m. on Saturday, June 22. More information will be available sale day.
6. Trucking will be available sale day. Cattle may not be loaded until after conclusion of field day. Cattle may be left at the farm for a reasonable time, if prior arrangements are made with landowner.
7. Any corrections of printed material will be addressed prior to the sale. Announcements made will supersede any catalog information.
8. All weaning age cattle being sold without dam at side, must be weaned 30 days prior to the auction.
9. All sale cattle must be registered "with the SPGCA" by consignor prior to being listed in the SPGCA sale catalog. Registration certificate on each animal will be transferred to the buyer at the association's expense. The buyer should be sure to give the clerk the proper name and address for making transfers.
10. A current health certificate is required on each consigned animal upon arrival. After the auction health certificates will be furnished on all sold animals as required for shipping.
11. Non-virgin bulls or bulls greater than 12 months of age must be trichomonas tested and negative results must accompany the bull upon arrival. These bulls must also pass a breeding soundness exam prior to the sale.
12. Mail or phone bids will be accepted, but arrangements must be made in advance by calling South Poll Grass Cattle Assn. officials at 256-996-3142.
13. All persons who attend this sale do so at their own risk and owners assume no liability or otherwise for any accidents which may occur.
14. Seller of animal must be a current member of the SPGCA.
15. SPGCA has the right to visually inspect and deny/refuse any cattle delivered for field day auction to maintain the standards expected of our breed.
16. All animals are consigned at the risk of the owner.

COWBOY AUCTION FORMAT

Each animal to be sold to the highest bidder. All cattle will have a base price as listed on rule #3. If more than one buyer is interested in purchasing a lot, the base price will be raised in \$100 increments until only one bidder is left.
